This Industry Advice Notice (IAN) from Department of Agriculture, Water and the Environment is to advise industry of the business continuity arrangements for plant export certificates due to the potential impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic.

In addition to this DAWE Industry Advice Notice, GTA had written to DAWE and the Minister for Agriculture supporting the adoption of “flexible arrangements” for phytosanitary certificates. GTA has also highlighted the potential disruption to trade that may emerge due to Covid-19 impacts on supply chain, shipping and payment processes.
