Update to the 2022/23 South Australian Location Differentials

1. Purpose

To advise members the GTA Board has approved the addition of additional Viterra sites to the 2022/23 GTA Location Differential (LDs) for South Australia (SA) as recommended by the GTA Commerce Committee.

The **updated SA LDs** are now available on the GTA [website](#) are effective from **1 October 2022**.

2. Background

GTA publishes the LDs for the storage locations of our members in QLD, NSW, VIC, SA and WA annually to enable participants using the GTA Contract No. 2 Grain and Oilseeds in Bulk – Basis Track to price grain at up-country sites. Each year GTA consults with members and the wider grain industry to address potential changes.

The industry has agreed to use Viterra and CBH Group published freight rates for South Australia (SA) and Western Australia (WA) each year, subject to approval by the GTA Commerce Committee and the GTA Board

The **additional Viterra sites** approved for the 2022/2023 GTA SA LDs are:

Site	Port	Location Differential
Cungena	Thevenard	\$21.72
Cungena	Port Lincoln	\$41.72
Tooligie	Port Lincoln	\$16.33

3. Location Differentials ARE NOT freight rates

GTA releases Location Differentials each year to enable pricing of the GTA No 2 Contract – *Contract for grain and oilseeds in bulk delivered* price basing point or port terms (Basis Track) commonly referred to as the “*Track Contract*”.

The GTA Location Differentials are not published to be a substitute for management of freight price risk and the variation between the LD and the actual cost of execution of freight should be managed by the **members** commercially.
